#### **BREAKOUT SESSION PRESENTER**

#### What should a breakout session include?

- A breakout session should challenge, inspire, and equip student leaders with new ideas, activities, and
  approaches in community engagement. This does not mean hard recruiting for any one organization,
  but rather, helping students see service and volunteerism in new ways, educating on current social or
  justice issues, and encouraging them get more involved.
- Breakout sessions should include at LEAST one interactive activity with students.
- Breakout sessions should include at LEAST one opportunity to share what schools are currently doing in your presentation interest area. Sharing is encouraged!
- A breakout session should not be lecture. It should incorporate idea sharing and best practices among students.

#### What is should I expect as a presenter?

- If your breakout session is chosen, workshop materials, presentation room specifications (including room capacity and A/V capabilities), and parking instructions will be sent 4 weeks prior to the Workshop for planning purposes.
- Parking validation is provided for presenters.
- University of Cincinnati students and/or event volunteers will aid in timekeeping for each breakout session. These students will stop a presentation once the session time has elapsed.
- Arrival at least 20 minutes before scheduled breakout session is strongly encouraged. Presenters will
  check-in at the registration table outside of the Great Hall and find the appropriate presentation space.
  There are 10 minutes between sessions.
